Dear Parent, Guardian and Fishing Club members,

I would like to first thank you for your interest in attending our Ward Melville Fishing Club Field trip upon the Double D Charters out of Montauk, NY on Monday Evening July 1st 2019. By signing the attached filed trip permission slip and returning it to the club advisor, you acknowledge the following:

- ✓ The duration of the trip runs from 5:00 PM till approximately 9:00 PM
 - **The boat will be leaving the dock at 5:00 PM sharp and if you are late, you will miss the boat and there will be no refund.**
 - **All students attending the field trip are required to provide their own transportation.**
- ✓ This trip is the first time we are doing a night striped bass trip. Those that organized the trip have first opportunity to hand their slips in and the remaining spots will then be open to lottery. Any Ward Melville Fishing Club member or student can attend this trip for a huge discount of \$50. Please see Mr. Wilson with any questions about this.
- ✓ There is only room for 8 students on this trip. This is an extremely limited load trip. If there is a desire for this trip again, we will look to a slightly larger boat to fish with.
- ✓ Due to the limited load of this trip, there may not be any room for non club members. We will have a waiting list so please get your information in right away.
- ✓ Target species for this trip will be striped bass. There will not be another option. We will be fishing on the NEW MOON which historically produces a very productive striped bass bite with jumbos being the norm. Every trip is different but we are setting ourselves up to be successful.
- ✓ All payments must be in the form of a check made payable to Three Village Central School District or TVCSD for \$50 (usual fare alone is \$125 plus tip) All necessary tackle and bait are provided for by the boat.

- ✓ **The trip is non-refundable.**
- ✓ In the event that we have more people looking to go on the trip than we have spots for, a waiting list will be created.
- ✓ The captain determines whether we sail or not. More details to follow on this and if the trip is canceled due to weather, you will be notified the night before at the very latest.
- ✓ Permission slips are due before we take our trip.
- ✓ Since this is a school related field trip, the Code of Conduct as outlined in the student handbook and also excerpted on the permission slip is in effect. All students are required to follow this code of conduct.
- ✓ Proper dress is an issue that must be addressed. If it rains, we will get wet so have at the very least a poncho if the weather calls for rain. Remember, it is easy to remove a layer of clothing but you can't put on what you didn't bring.

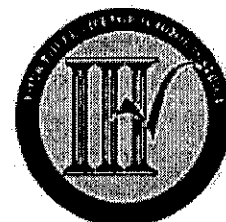
